**Highlights:**

- Total system ridership for June decreased 17.2% or about 846,000 rides. In comparison to last year, there was one additional weekday and one less Sunday in June. In comparison to last year, average weekday ridership dropped 19.81%, triggering a loss of over 41,000 trips per day. Compared to last year, year-to-date system ridership decreased 9.6% or approximately 2,700,000 rides. Bus ridership in June decreased 16.1% or approximately 657,000 rides.
- HealthLine ridership continues to grow. 309,500 rides were taken in June, a 41.35% increase over last year. Compared to the #6 route it replaced, about 90,500 more rides were taken.
- Rapid Transit ridership decreased by 23.85% in June. Light Rail decreased 27.4% for the month and Heavy Rail decreased 15.6% year to date. Many Light and Heavy Rail shut downs in June could have triggered a loss in ridership for the month.
- Community Circulator ridership decreased 47.3% and 83,132 less rides taken in June.
- Trolley ridership decreased for the first time since the line opened in April 2006. During June, over 80,000 rides were taken, a 15% decrease when compared to last year. Average daily trolley ridership is 3,652 rides, a 19.1% decrease when compared to last year.
- 4,430 bikes were boarded in June. That is a 21% decrease over last year. Year-to-date bike related trips are 15,221.

***Ridership Initiatives and Special Promotions:***

- During June, several new clients signed up for the Commuter Advantage program including: Sisters of Charity Foundation of Cleveland, U.S. Department of Justice Anti-Trust, Buckingham, Doolittle & Burroughs LLP, Family Medicine, and Hard Rock Café.
- RTA began the education process to riders about the new Proof-of-Payment system on the Red Line. Volunteers were positioned at stations around town to get the word out about the new procedure. Demonstrations were also given on the new Ticket Vending Machines and Customer Service Kiosks.
- In June, several events occurred around the city, including concerts at the House of Blues, Blossom Music Center and Time Warner Cable Amphitheater, as well as numerous Cleveland Indians home games. To accommodate the large crowds of spectators, RTA offered additional rail service. In addition, RTA has more than 7,000 free parking spaces at rail stations and park-and-ride lots to ensure safe, speedy, and affordable travel to and from events.
- During the month of June, RTA participated in several community events throughout the Greater Cleveland area including speaking engagements and informational sessions at Ivy Plaza Senior Apartments, Helen S. Brown Community Center, Huron Road Hospital Conference, Mr. Auburn Senior Apartments, Gates Mills Villa Senior Apartments, Fairhill Center, Gunning Goldenage Center, Ernest Bohn Goldenage Center, ABC's of Medicare and Senior Services in East Cleveland, Parma Senior Center, Kirby Manor in Lakewood, Coventry Arts Festival, Lakeshore Goldenage Senior Fair, Ward 5 Community Festival, and Safety Day at the Zoo. Also attended meetings for Transit Improvement Advisory Committee, Citizen's Advisory Board, Cleveland Heights Community Meeting, and Brand Management. By design, these events increase RTA's presence within the Greater Cleveland community and enhance public transit awareness.
