Highlights:

- Total system ridership for August decreased 15.6% or about 775,000 rides. In comparison to last year, there was the same number of weekdays, Saturdays and Sundays in August. In comparison to last year, average weekday ridership dropped 15.58%, triggering a loss of over 31,900 trips per day. Compared to last year, year-to-date system ridership decreased 11.6% or approximately 4,400,000 rides. Bus ridership in August decreased 16.9% or approximately 618,000 rides.
- HealthLine ridership continues to grow. 311,300 rides were taken in August, a 38.6% increase over last year. Compared to the #6 route it replaced, about 86,000 more rides were taken.
- Rapid Transit ridership decreased by 18.25% in August. Light Rail decreased 18.54% for the month and Heavy Rail decreased 17.4% year to date.
- Community Circulator ridership decreased 49% and 89,885 less rides taken in August.
- Trolley ridership decreased during August 8.7%, or 92,312 rides when compared to last year. Average daily trolley ridership is 4,396 rides, an 8.7% decrease when compared to last year.
- 5,429 bikes were boarded in August. That is a 17.9% decrease over last year. Year-to-date bike related trips are 25,955.

Ridership Initiatives and Special Promotions:

- During August, several new clients signed up for the Commuter Advantage program including: LPC Publishing Company, Optiem, Cleveland Magazine and Kordalski Architects.
- August was the beginning of the long awaited Proof of Payment system on the Red Line. RTA staff members and volunteers were positioned at key Red Line stations to assist riders with the new Ticket Vending Machines (TVMs) and the Proof of Payment system procedures. The volunteers were out in force for two full weeks providing assistance and education. Many Cleveland Indians games during this period proved that the Proof of Payment system would be successful and easy, even for irregular RTA riders.
- RTA provided Informational Trip Planning sessions to help displaced circulator riders in preparation for their elimination on September 20. The meetings lasted two weeks and were held in each of the community circulator neighborhoods. RTA received many comments and suggestions regarding where people were going and why the service is important to them. Over 700 people collectively attended these meetings.
- The annual RTA Charity Golf Outing was held on Saturday August 16 at Geneva on the Lake Golf Course.
- On August 26, RTA broke ground for the new East 55th Street Rapid Station. In attendance were Mayor Frank Jackson, Councilman Anthony Brancatelli, Councilwoman Phyllis Cleveland, Diane Downing from Senator Voinovich's office, and ODOT Director Jolene Molitoris. Approximately fifty people were in attendance.
- In August, several events occurred around the city, including concerts at the House of Blues, Quicken Loans Arena and Time Warner Cable Amphitheater, Heartwalk, Jonas Brothers at the Q, as well as numerous Cleveland Indians home games and Cleveland Browns exhibition games. To accommodate the large crowds of spectators, RTA offered additional rail service. In addition, RTA has more than 7,000 free parking spaces at rail stations and park-and-ride lots to ensure safe, speedy, and affordable travel to and from events.
- During the month of August, RTA participated in several community events throughout the Greater Cleveland area including speaking engagements and informational sessions at Kirby Manor Senior Apartments, R.H. Myer's Senior Apartments at Menorah Park, Sterling Oaks Senior Apartments, City of Cleveland Wellness Fair, CMHA Senior Jamboree, St. Andrew's Towers Senior Fair, Case Western Reserve University's Orientation Fair. In addition to these events, also attended and coordinated the Citizen's Advisory Board Meeting and the Big Truck and Safety Day at the Warrensville Library. By design, these events increase RTA's presence within the Greater Cleveland community and enhance public transit awareness.
